



BRIAN ICKLER: Career Highlights

2010

- Joined Kyle Busch Motorsports as co-driver of the No. 18 Toyota Tundra in the NASCAR Camping World Truck Series.

2009

- Drove 11 Truck Series races for Billy Ballew Motorsports and scored a fifth-place finish in his very first outing at Kansas Speedway in Kansas City.
- Scored his first career Truck Series pole at Michigan International Speedway in Brooklyn, where he went on to finish third. Added a ninth-place finish in his last race of the season at Las Vegas Motor Speedway.
- Drove his own Ickler Motorsports entry in three NASCAR Camping World East/West Series races.
- Scored a victory in April at Greenville-Pickens (S.C.) Speedway in the East Series and added a second-place finish to NASCAR Sprint Cup Series regular Kyle Busch in an East Series race in May at Iowa Speedway in Newton. Added an eighth-place finish in the West Series race at Iowa in September.
- Drove a pair of NASCAR Nationwide Series races in the Braun Racing Toyota with a best finish of 26th at Memphis (Tenn.) Motorsports Park.
- Finished in the top-five in four of six starts in the ARCA/REMAX Series driving his own Ickler Motorsports entry. Qualified on the pole at Kentucky Speedway in Sparta and Chicagoland Speedway in Joliet, Ill.

2008

- Ran the full Camping World East Series schedule, scoring wins at Iowa, South Boston (Va.) Speedway and Mansfield (Ohio) Motorsports Park, and nabbing poles at Dover (Del.) International Speedway and Stafford (Conn.) Motor Speedway
- Finished 10th in the season-ending East Series point standings with five top-10 finishes and led all drivers in laps led.

2007

- Finished fourth in the Camping World West Series championship driving for Bill McAnally Racing, with a series-leading three wins at Douglas County Speedway in Roseburg, Ore., Irwindale (Calif.) Raceway and Evergreen Speedway in Monroe, Wash., along with poles at Elko (Minn.) Speedway, Colorado National Speedway in Erie, and Altamont Motorsports Park in Tracy, Calif., and scored seven top-10s.
- Earned the NASCAR Grand National West Division Achievement Award for the second year in a row.
- Added a pair of East Series races for McAnally's team with a best finish of 11th at Mansfield.

2006

- Signed with McAnally Racing to drive in the Camping World West Series, scoring best finishes of second at Infineon Raceway in Sonoma, Calif. (to Sprint Cup regular Brian Vickers) and Thunder Hill Raceway in Kyle, Texas.
- Earned his first Grand National West Division Achievement Award.
- Won the qualifying race at the Toyota All-Star Showdown at Irwindale and finished fifth in the main event.

2005

- In 15 starts in the Super Late Model division of the NASCAR Dodge Weekly Series at Irwindale, scored one win (200-lap Hot Wheels Invitational), six top-fives, nine top-10s and one pole.

2004

- Began preparation for his transition from off-road to oval-track racing.

2003

- Southern California Off-Road Enthusiasts (SCORE) Rookie of the Year after clinching the A-Class championship with five wins, including the prestigious Baja 1000
- Earned the Toyota Milestone Award for completing all 2,086 miles run during the six-event SCORE season.

2001

- Began racing in the SCORE off-road series.
